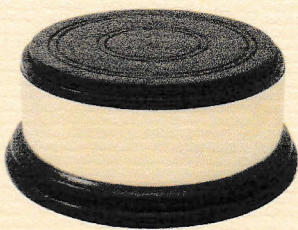
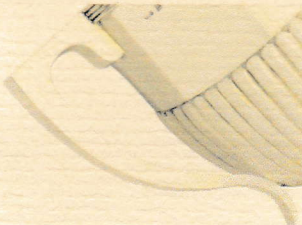




Vintage George VI Sterling Silver Presentation/Champagne Cup

This fine vintage George VI sterling silver presentation/champagne cup has a circular bell shaped form onto a waisted cylindrical pedestal and circular spreading stepped foot. The lower portion of the body is embellished with impressive fluted decoration. The rim of the cup and foot, in addition to the upper portion of the pedestal, are encircled with impressive applied reed style decorated borders. This large cup is fitted with fine and impressive plain angular handles with subtly flared lower terminals. By virtue of its size, this versatile cup could be used as a champagne cooler or a fine presentation cup. This cup is fitted to a circular ebonised black painted wood plinth, encircled with a plain silver band; the band may be engraved with a personal inscription if so desired.
